



Habitat for Humanity South Hampton Roads ReStore Blue Hat Program

ReStores are our thrift stores, but we do not sell clothing, we sell furniture, housewares, appliances and building supplies. All money raised go to cover administrative costs of our organization so that all other donations we receive can go to help build another home for a family that qualifies to purchase one.

Volunteers in the ReStore help sort donations, unload our donation trucks, assist customers and help maintain the ReStore.

Responsibilities:

- Pledge one-year minimum to the program, with a weekly shift commitment (when possible).
- Act as shift leaders for volunteers at our ReStores.
- Greet the daily volunteers, help get them signed in and briefed on HabitatSHR's mission and programs.
- Guide volunteers in an engaging and safe manner.
- Work closely with ReStore Director and staff to determine the needs of that day and how best to employ volunteers.
- Take care of daily tasks, special projects, and supply management
- Help keep the ReStore clean and clutter free
- Greet customers and interact in a friendly manner, offering assistance when needed.
- Must attend an orientation and training along with a quarterly meeting.
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds and work in an open air environment (no heating or air conditioning).

This pilot program will be located at our 900 Tidewater Drive ReStore location in Norfolk and will be expanded to include our Virginia Beach ReStore once the program is up and running with a full team of Blue Hats.
