From the BOARD PRESIDENT & EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

n the early stages of the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic, drastic personnel reductions and cost cutting actions were taken to keep Habitat SHR solvent. With the leadership and hard work exhibited by the senior staff, the oversight and encouragement provided by the Board of Directors, the unwavering dedication of our volunteers and the financial support of your donations, Habitat SHR was able to restart operations. Thanks to the efforts of all of the aforementioned, two new Habitat partner families were able to purchase the homes of their dreams. Additionally, two other houses were started in late 2020. Both are projected to be sold by the time this Annual Report is released.

In recognition of its mission supporting low-income families and communities in South Hampton Roads, Habitat SHR's was selected as the recipient of the prestigious Bank of America 2020 Neighborhood Builder Award. In addition to receiving a grant, the Executive Director and an emerging leader, Retail Director Lizette Quinn, will receive leadership training opportunities during 2021 sponsored by the Bank of America.

We must build upon the 2020 momentum in order to return to our goal of building and selling six homes per year. Lack of affordable land and rehab houses to purchase are a major threat to attaining this goal. To counter the critical lack of buildable properties, Habitat SHR established a self-sustaining Land Acquisition Fund/Land Bank (LAF/LB) in 2020 with a targeted goal of \$500,000. To date, \$170,000 has been raised. Once fully funded, the LAF/LB will be able to support the building of approximately ten homes. Because, the land acquisition funds are returned to the LAF/LB after each closing, the fund is self-sustaining in perpetuity.

Another threat impacting affordable housing is the increasing cost and non-availability of lumber and other building materials. These costs are projected to increase another 30% this spring building season. In the short term, to off-set these costs and to ensure availability when needed, we are pre-purchasing home construction lumber packages and ordering other materials, like windows, early. We are looking to establish a Construction Working Capital Fund, similar to the LAF/LB, which will ensure that funding is readily available to meet future housing construction goals.

As our important stakeholders, we want to assure you that we are diligently working to deliver affordable homes. However, none of our accomplishments would be achievable without the tremendous support of you, our donors.
